

# Message From Fr. Jeff



VERY IMPORTANT: Establishing the Atmosphere at St Patrick: Hospitality and Mercy:

We are continuing to build an atmosphere of hospitality. In God's merciful Heart is the space which our children and families need in order to grow like a flower toward the Son, toward Heaven.

It requires **deliberate care and a deliberate attempt to understand**. If we stop watering a flower even for one or two days, it will die. CCD (understanding) and Eucharist is watering the flowers.

What message do we want to send your children?

Most of the CCD teachers are dedicated parents with kids in all kinds of activities just like you! And all of the teachers whether parents or not, understand your complicated situation. They volunteer out of love. We are Merciful!! But what is mercy?

Mercy is Love of God above all:

What prevails in society is hatred and brokenness especially in the family. Unless we elevate human life and upgrade it to SUPERNATURAL LOVE, even our attempts to do good will continue to fall way short. That is why Jesus says, "Love one another as I HAVE LOVED YOU".

Mercy is not humanism ; it is not philanthropy. Philanthropy without SUPERNATURAL LOVE cannot break the cycle of fear , hatred and unhappiness . History has proved that. Without Love of God above all , we cannot offer SUPERNATURAL LOVE or mercy correctly to one another.

### All hands on board:

We are trying to build a community of parents and children based on SUPERNATURAL LOVE. CCD IS NOT A MATTER OF TIME BUT OF LOVE, SUPERNATURAL LOVE.

"I don't want to go to religion class" "I don't want to go to Mass" is all the more reason to come because those are definite signs of a lack of mercy, a lack of supernatural love or Love of God. If Love of God is our motive, we can overcome ourselves and be better for each other. This is what the Scriptures mean by holiness or wholeness and thus, the purpose of CCD.

"I don't want to force faith on my child" How can our children choose what is good or bad without understanding? Children don't choose to go to the dentist or to the doctor. Once they understand the good in it, they still do not want to go to the dentist or doctor, but they will go because they UNDERSTAND THE GOOD IN IT. Choosing to help children understand is not the same as forcing religion down their throats. Better understanding is necessary for better choices. Only understanding cuts through errors and deceit. We do not want to enable spiritual laziness or sloth as an excuse.

TRUST then is the real issue. I TRUST THAT IF I make this sacrifice of love and not simply follow my feelings, GOOD IS GOING TO COME FROM IT BECAUSE GOD IS GOOD, SUPERNATURAL LOVE. In the end, I will probably feel better anyway.

So we need every one to help plant these seeds of Supernatural Love, understanding, trust in His Mercy and be merciful to one another. We need every one to give it our best!





# **Registration & Safety** HOW TO REGISTER A STUDENT



**New CCD Student Registration:** will be available May 15th via any of the following methods: on the parish website, parish APP or in person during the secretary's office hours. Registration forms will also be available at the church entrances; or outside the parish office (which is located by the Adoration Chapel at the back of the main church).

**Existing CCD Students:** will automatically be enrolled at the end of this school year, into the next grade. A statement acknowledging the enrollment will be sent via email (if a current email is available) or sent via mail (if a current email is not available), which will also include the tuition fees due for the new year. You will be asked to confirm/decline the enrollment by submitting the form back to the parish office, along with any fees that are due. No one is ever denied the chance to heal, grow and practice their faith, because of financial difficulties. This concern should not be an influence in a person's decision to enroll in a class. ### ENROLLMENT AND TUITION PAYMENTS

**CCD Class Enrollment and Tuition Payments:** If you have not confirmed your child's enrollment, please do so. Everyone that attended last year, was automatically advanced into the next formation grade this year, but we still need confirmation from each family confirming that enrollment. Enrollment acknowledgments and tuition statements were sent out via email (if there is an valid active email address on file) or regular mail (if no email address is listed) ON May 30, 2017. ## St. Patrick Church Safe Children Pedestrian & Vehicular Traffic Procedures

**Our Goal:** Provide safe & efficient pedestrian travel for your kids as they arrive and exit from CCD class. Please read the following safe procedures outlined below:

### When Dropping Off:

- 1. Please enter the lower entrance off Mills Rd. If you enter the upper entrance, you will be directed by signs to enter the right, lower parking lot and rejoin the drop off line.
- 2. When stopping to allow your children to exit the vehicle:
  - \* FIRST, pull up to the closest available space by the crosswalk, without blocking the crosswalk. This will allow several vehicles to unload at the same time!
  - \* SECOND PLEASE HAVE YOUR CHILDREN READY TO EXIT THE RIGHT SIDE OF YOUR VEHICLE. This allows vehicles to go around the left side of the drop off area, only if a vehicle in front of them has a delay in unloading their children), because the oncoming traffic will be prevented from driving along the front of church.
- 3. ALL 2nd GRADE STUDENTS MUST BE WALKED TO THEIR CLASSROOM BY THEIR PARENTS.
- 4. To do this please park in the back lot in front of the New Rectory. To pull in this lot, follow the sign by the lower entrance. When exiting this back lot, DO NOT go out the way you came in. Instead exit at the other end of the parking lot and join the flow of the drop off line.
- 5. 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade will be dropped off at the Old Rectory. Please pull through the semi-circle, as much as possible when dropping off your child, to allow for other cars to pull in behind you and not clog up the street.
- 6. If you would like to walk your child to class or anticipate taking a long time to unload, please park in the back right lot and use the crosswalks.
- 7. THE CCD PROGRAM WILL HAVE AN ADULT WATCHING THE CHILDREN ENTERING INTO CHURCH, so that you won't contribute to the traffic backing up by watching them enter into church.
- 8. We have truly been blessed with an enormous growth at our church, but unfortunately we have more traffic. Therefore, PLEASE COME EARLY, CCD CLASSES BEGIN AT 9:30 AM!

When Picking Up Children to Go Home: PLEASE ARRIVE EARLY & park in only striped, designated parking spots in the back right lot, NOT in any of the driveways. All children in the Parish Hall MUST be picked up in person. Do not turn around, stop or park in the intersections, because there are too many pedestrians exiting the building. CCD ends at 10:40 for all children. Please wait for doors to be opened to the Hall and back entrance. Parents should tell students in the Old Rectory where to meet them. For more details see the parent packet.

With everyone's patience & cooperation we will achieve our goal for a safe & efficient way to enter & exit with our children, families & the rest of the parishioners in our church!

### Attendance for Safety

Because we have considerably less time than parochial schools have to teach your children the same material, good attendance in any CCD Program is very important. Here at St. Patrick we would like to strongly encourage that the children are to be here as much as possible, so we can minister to their spiritual needs. Please make every effort to make CCD classes and activities a <u>priority</u> for your family, as well as weekly attendance at Mass. Emails will be sent home on weeks a student is absent to explain the make-up process.

We do understand however that sickness, family issues, etc. can interfere with regular attendance. If you have special needs please feel free to come and talk to us so that arrangements can be made. If there are an excessive number of absences, you will be contacted and may be asked to repeat the grade level. Please make us aware of any situation that may cause your child's absence. We can then support you in keeping them caught up.

### Make Up Procedure



If a child misses class, there is a makeup procedure for the student to make up for the session content he or she did not get from the missed class. It is the parent's responsibility to go over this with your child and make sure he or she is current in their studies, when they return to class. If there are extenuating circumstances, please contact us.

During and absence, you will receive a letter stating the following:

Growth in Virtue We have to help the youth grow in virtues that will help them the rest of their life. Faith,Hope, Love, Temperance, Fortitude, Prudence and Justice. We do this in different ways.

Good discipline and self control are important to effective learning. We want all the children to feel comfortable expressing themselves, but it is also important for them to know their boundaries. Students are expected to be respectful, courteous and considerate of the teachers and the other students. Talk to your child about appropriate classroom behavior.

If there continues to be a behavioral problem in class, the child will be sent to the Religious Education Office and parents will be notified.

Students are <u>not permitted</u> to bring <u>electronic devices</u> to class, unless otherwise specified by the teacher for a specific project.

### Family Work <u>It is the parent's role to be the pri</u> <u>mary educators in their child's reli-</u> <u>gious education</u>.

It is our goal to **support** you in any way possible as members of the Body of Christ through spiritual formation in the CCD Program. If you ever have any questions about what your child is learning, please contact us. We are making every effort to have an open line of communication with each parent. You will find contact information on the last page of this packet. You are always welcome to call the parish office and leave a message. The secretary will make sure the message gets to the appropriate person. Teachers will send home email updates to further inform you about what your children are learning. Books will come home with the students each week for grades 1-6, so you may review the material with them. We encourage this. Remember, children learn by example. Please be sure to send the books back to class with your children each Sundav!

### Sacraments

It is a privilege to help prepare your child for the Sacraments: Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation. Your support is necessary in this process. We have many activities planned to help the children prepare for this special time in their life. Besides these activities, there will be parent meetings, practices, and projects.
