

A Parish Community Garden has long been on Father Jeff's radar as well as a goal of the Parish Council.

Special thanks go out to Eagle Scout Jack Gercken and team, who worked tirelessly repairing and replacing the 3,060 square foot garden fence. The fence is to keep deer and other animals outside the garden.

Once the fence was repaired, parish volunteers spent hours building two large raised beds, rototilling, planting and watering.


