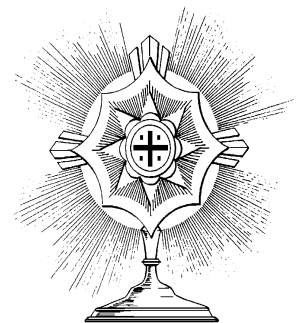

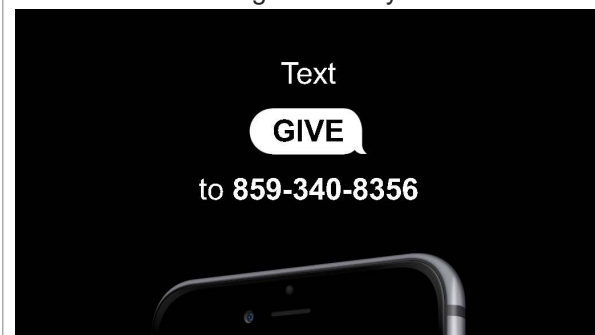

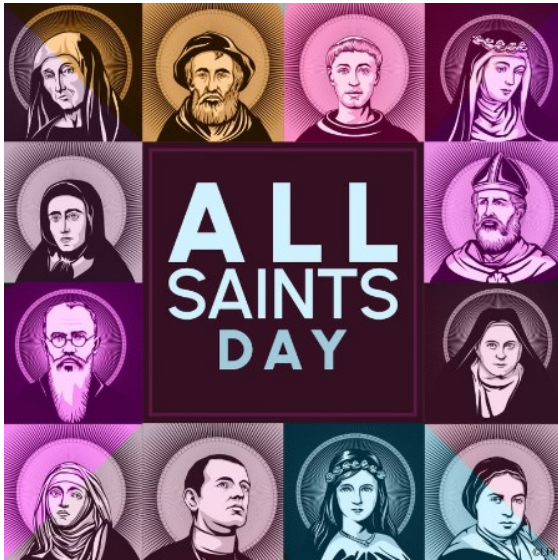


CHRISTMAS CHOIR – 2023

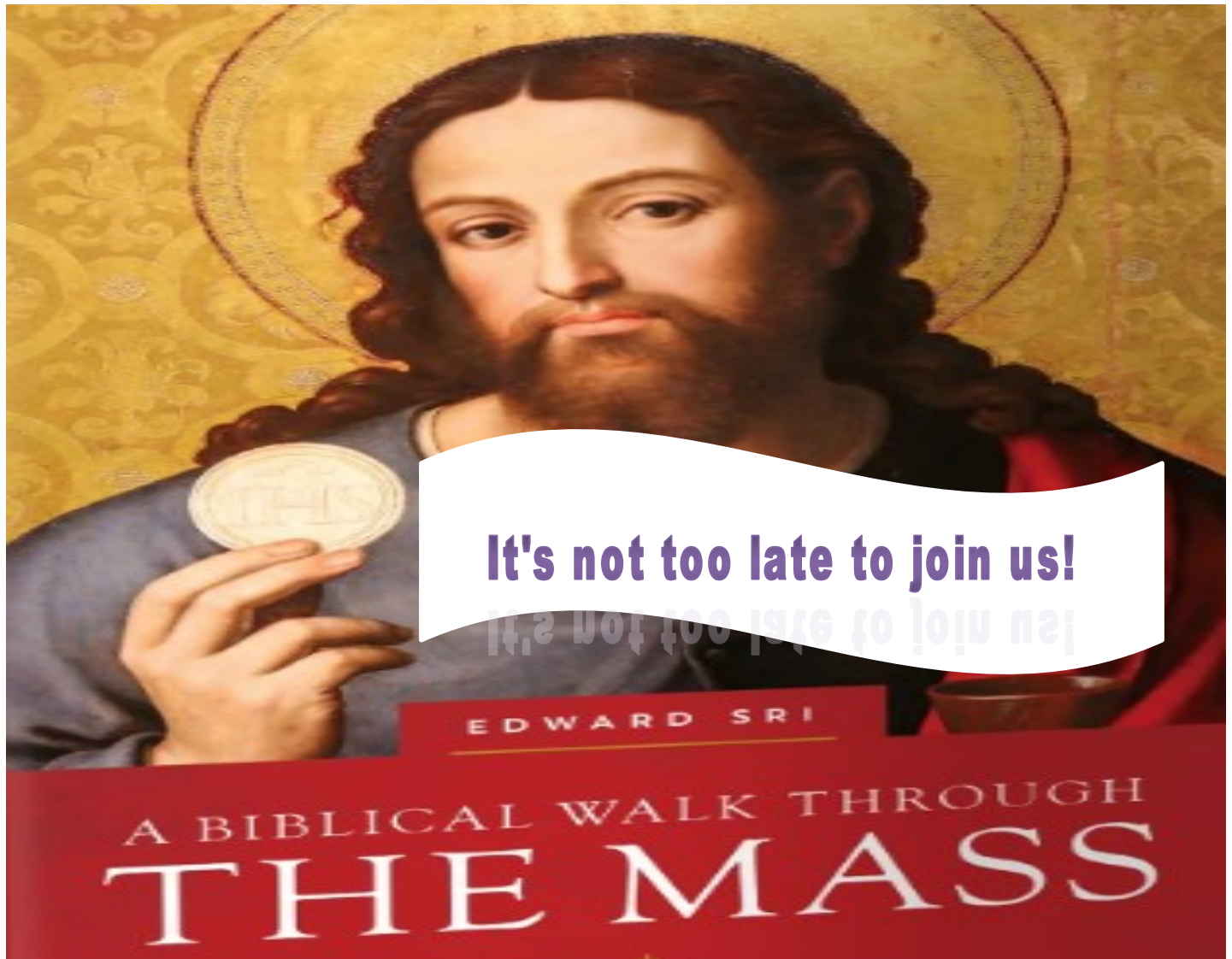

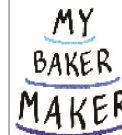
