PADRE'S PATCH UPDATE

After all the heavy rains, I was pleased that we could use the walking paths to begin weeding again. Many plants have evidence of pests (leaves with holes). We have been spraying organic Neem which protects plants from being eaten. I have a concentrate at home and will refill as needed, please don't discard the spray bottles. Patches of poison ivy are growing along the fenceline. We sprayed it on Monday after the rain with Organic weed killer. Small ribbons have been tied on the fence to identify the areas of invasion.

Critters are getting in under some areas of the fence. I saw a bunny running under the fence next to the statue of St. Fiacre; a temporary fix by placing 3 watering cans to block the opening. I hope to find some pieces of board to place where holes exist. Nothing is more disappointing than having the fruits of our labor destroyed in their infancy, even by cute, hungry bunnies.!

We have begun taking our harvest to the tented area in styrofoam coolers whereby Pam Nunnally puts them in the walk-in frig. Hopefully, we can rinse off produce on Saturday mornings and place them in wire baskets for weekend masses. Anyone willing and available on the weekends to help out, please reach out.

Upcoming projects: We have skids that should be delivered to the garden within the next week when our composting project will officially begin; if anyone has thoughts or knowledge of construction, best practices, do's and don'ts please share.

I am thankful for having a team of fellow garden enthusiasts!

Our newest endeavor, parishioners recently spent a long, hard day beautifying the Our Lady of Knock garden, located behind the chapel. Weeding and pruning the existing foliage has made a difference. It is very timely as St. Patrick's celebrates the annual Novena of Our Lady of Knock August 14th- 22nd. (Our Lady silently appeared to peasants in a small village in Knock, Ireland in 1879.) These parishioners have a special devotion to the Blessed Virgin and have refurbished several deteriorated statues of Our Lady, including the statue in our Our Lady of Knock Shrine. Other parishioners keep the water flowing at our grotto, working as husband and wife together, frequently troubleshooting the pumps at St. Patrick's. Another family planted a fig tree to honor Father Jeff's 40 years as a priest. All quietly working in the background for Christ's glory, not their own. Fun fact: Father Josh Heskamp laid the rock wall years ago that is still standing tall.

Our Lady of Knock Novena

August 14-22, 2025
St Patrick Parish and Shrine, Taylor Mill, KY

St. Patrick invites all the faithful to seek the intercession of Our Lady of Knock, the Blessed Virgin Mary to realize the love of Jesus and the peace and guidance of His mother Mary more deeply. Every August, parishioners and pilgrims come to St. Patrick Catholic Parish Shrine and School in Taylor Mill, Kentucky to seek the intercession of Our Lady of Knock, the Blessed Virgin Mary. "Lady of Knock" was so titled during an apparition in Knock, Ireland in 1879. "The Story of Knock began on the 21st of August 1879, when, at approximately 8 o'clock in the evening, fifteen people from the village of Knock in County Mayo, Ireland, witnessed an Apparition of Our Lady, St. Joseph, St. John the Evangelist, a Lamb and Cross on an altar at the gable wall of the Parish Church. The witnesses watched the apparition in the pouring rain for two hours, reciting the rosary. Although they themselves were saturated, not a single drop of rain fell on the gable or vision. Though not a word was spoken by Our Lady, St. Joseph and St. John during the silent apparition at Knock, the vision spoke louder than words with an eloquent message uniting earth and heaven. The fifteen official witnesses, most of whom were from the village of Knock and surrounding areas and ranged in age from 5 to 74 years old. Each of the witnesses gave testimonies to a Commission of Enquiry in October 1879. The findings of the Commission were that the testimonies were both trustworthy and satisfactory."

HOW ST. PAT'S CAME TO BE HER DESIGNATED SHRINE

In October 2007, Bishop Foys designated St. Patrick Church in Taylor Mill a Shrine to Our Lady of Knock. In May 2009, Knock Shrine in Ireland blessed St. Patrick Shrine with a piece of the gable wall where Mary appeared in 1879. In addition, the grotto behind St. Patrick's Adoration Chapel was blessed by the bishop where a statue of Our Lady was placed and dedicated, eyes directly on Christ. Please join us for Mass and Adoration for as many days as possible for a deep and

inspirational prayer experience. Adoration of the Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Blessed Sacrament is also available 24 hours a day in the chapel.


