Our Lady of Knock Novena

August 14-22, 2025
St Patrick Parish and Shrine, Taylor Mill, KY

St. Patrick invites all the faithful to seek the intercession of Our Lady of Knock, the Blessed Virgin Mary to realize the love of Jesus and the peace and guidance of His mother Mary more deeply. Every August, parishioners and pilgrims come to St. Patrick Catholic Parish Shrine and School in Taylor Mill, Kentucky to seek the intercession of Our Lady of Knock, the Blessed Virgin Mary. "Lady of Knock" was so titled during an apparition in Knock, Ireland in 1879. "The Story of Knock began on the 21st of August 1879, when, at approximately 8 o'clock in the evening, fifteen people from the village of Knock in County Mayo, Ireland, witnessed an Apparition of Our Lady, St. Joseph, St. John the Evangelist, a Lamb and Cross on an altar at the gable wall of the Parish Church. The witnesses watched the apparition in the pouring rain for two hours, reciting the rosary. Although they themselves were saturated, not a single drop of rain fell on the gable or vision. Though not a word was spoken by Our Lady, St. Joseph and St. John during the silent apparition at Knock, the vision spoke louder than words with an eloquent message uniting earth and heaven. The fifteen official witnesses, most of whom were from the village of Knock and surrounding areas and ranged in age from 5 to 74 years old. Each of the witnesses gave testimonies to a Commission of Enquiry in October 1879. The findings of the Commission were that the testimonies were both trustworthy and satisfactory."

HOW ST. PAT'S CAME TO BE HER DESIGNATED SHRINE

In October 2007, Bishop Foys designated St. Patrick Church in Taylor Mill a Shrine to Our Lady of Knock. In May 2009, Knock Shrine in Ireland blessed St. Patrick Shrine with a piece of the gable wall where Mary appeared in 1879. In addition, the grotto behind St. Patrick's Adoration Chapel was blessed by the bishop where a statue of Our Lady was placed and dedicated, eyes directly on Christ. Please join us for Mass and Adoration for as many days as possible for a deep and

inspirational prayer experience. Adoration of the Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament is also available 24 hours a day in the chapel.
